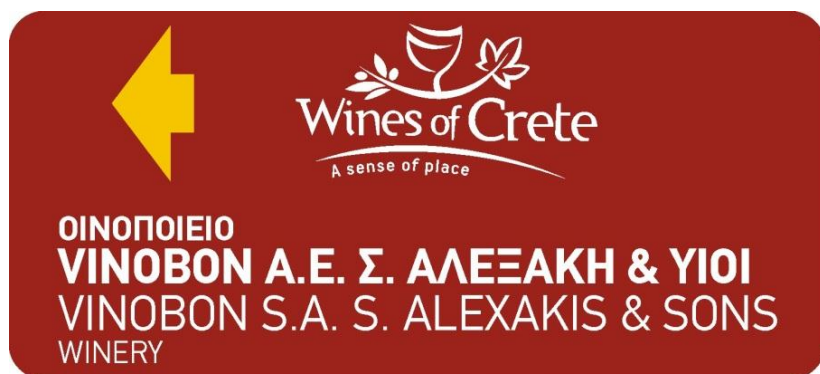




Port of Heraklion, 03.07.2012.
